PRE-1900 SETTLER/PIONEER FAMILIES

Who Should Fill This In?

If the earliest member of your family to settle in NZ came by boat from overseas before 1900, and settled in the TCDC/HDC area at some stage in their lifetime, then we would appreciate you filling this in. These people are 'settlers'. They may have spent time in another country first (eg Australia), or another area of NZ (eg Auckland), before coming to Thames. They do not need to have stayed in Thames - they may have moved on after a few years, or after a couple of generations. Children who entered the country with them are also settlers and will need their own information sheet, as well as being recorded on the back of their parents sheet.

We would also like to trace any people born in NZ and living in the TCDC/HDC area before 1900 (pioneer families).

You may not be able to fill in all the details - even just the names is a help. These forms can always be updated, revised, or replaced at a later date. You may require more sheets for children, or for other branches of your family (spouses etc) who you may have information on. Please feel free to photocopy, or otherwise, request more sheets.

Additional Information Page 1

Not essential but - very brief - anything of particular note this person did - any places they lived/worked at, any particulars which add to ease of identifying them.

Additional Information Page 2

Not essential but - very brief - anything of interest about the descendants eg a son taught in Paeroa; a grandson had a ??? business in Thames; most/all of the family have left the District. Any noteworthy descendant (even if not in District) eg well-known artist Joe Bloggs of Auckland is a member of this family.
